



## SIIT Successfully Hosts AOFUA Summer Camp 2024

Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT) successfully hosted the AOFUA Summer Camp 2024 from July 4-12, 2024. The event was conducted in two formats: online from July 4-5 and hybrid from July 10-13. This initiative was part of the Asia-Oceania Five Universities Alliance (AOFUA) collaboration.

The theme for this year's Summer Camp was "Smart and Sustainable Supply Chain Management." The program included lectures, workshops, and field trips aimed at helping students understand the significance of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the application of efficient technologies for sustainable development.

SIIT welcomed a total of 36 students from alliance universities to participate in the activities, along with executive delegations from AOFUA universities who attended the closing ceremony on July 12. The Asia-Oceania Five Universities Alliance (AOFUA) includes De La Salle University (the Philippines), Edith Cowan University (Australia), Malaysia-Japan International Institute of Technology (MJIT) at Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (Malaysia), Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT) at Thammasat University (Thailand), and Tokyo City University (Japan). The alliance aims to foster development, build networks, and expand sustainable academic collaborations.
